Scottish and Southern Electricity Networks maintain a Network Geographical Information System (GIS) also known as Electric Office (EO) which represents the assets on the network in a geographical form.

Electric Office provides a cross-technology end-to-end view of the electricity network, combining the fully connected electrical system with Google mapping systems. You must log in to use Electric Office.
